SCHEDULE: The scheduled camp day runs from 9 a.m. - 4 p.m. Before-camp care from 6:30 a.m.-9 a.m. and after-camp care from 4-6 p.m. is available at no additional charge for full-day campers.

*Camp Lagoon and Camp Tarpon morning care runs from 7-9 a.m.

*For Camp Muskogee campers, morning and afternoon care is available at bus stop locations only; it is not available at Camp Muskogee.
