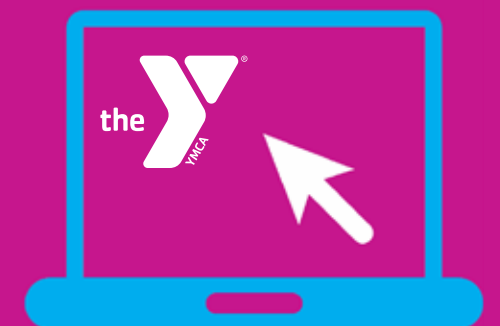

## ABOUT OUR CAMPS

**PARENT ORIENTATION:** Parents must attend a mandatory parent orientation.

**NOTE:** Campers should be acclimated to large groups and being away from parents. Previous attendance in a school environment helps prepare campers for their summer camp experience. Also, children must have completed the 5th grade in order to attend this camp.
