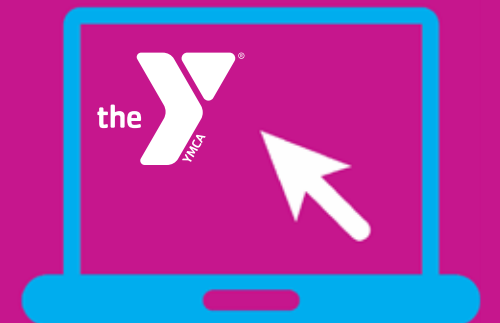

ABOUT OUR CAMPS

Our camp provides youth with activities that teach values, conflict resolution and leadership skills. Campers will participate in specialty activities aligned with the weeks themes, arts and crafts, games and more!

WHAT TO BRING: Campers should arrive in comfortable clothes and closed-toed shoes, with two snacks, a healthy lunch, reusable water bottle and spray sunscreen. Campers must also bring a swimsuit and towel.

EXTENDED CARE: Campers can attend Morning Care from 7-9 a.m. and Afternoon Care from 4-6 p.m. for no additional fee.

ADVENTURE CAMPS

Learning and Growing (Ages 3-4 and 5)

This half-day camp gives your camper an opportunity to experience camp through activities designed to promote belonging and achievement. Campers will participate in arts, crafts, songs, stories, socialization, educational/developmental activities and more! **NOTE: Campers must be potty-trained. Before- and after- care and early drop-off and late pickup are not available.**

Osprey Camp (Ages 6-8 and 9-11)

Adventure Camp campers have the opportunity to find new talents, try new activities, gain independence, and make lasting friendships and memories. Weekly themed activities allow campers to create arts, crafts, explore science and technology, swim, and so much more!

OSPREY ADD ONS NEW!

Campers can choose to stay at Camp Osprey and enjoy a fun filled day of adventure, OR they can choose to enhance their camp experience by selecting an ADD ON camp option during select weeks. We have two options to choose from: Specialty Camp OR Tennis & Aquatics Camp.

*Campers ages 6-8 will need to pay a weekly fee for Add Ons. This addition is free for campers ages 9-11, however, they do not get to attend field trips.



Specialty Camp ADD ON Option (Ages 6-8 and 9-11)

Does your camper dream of being a scientist, inventor, or baker? It's easy to enhance any week with new and engaging adventures and experiences by simply choosing one of our Specialty Camp options.

For approximately four hours a day, campers will get engaged in activities specific to their added specialty. After specialty camp, the participants will return to Camp Osprey for swimming and all other activities.



Tennis and Aquatics Camp ADD ON Option (Ages 6-8 and 9-11)

Our tennis camp is designed to teach the basic, intermediate and advanced skills. Campers are put into smaller groups based on skill level so each child can receive more individualized attention.

Aquatic camp focuses on fine-tuning campers swim strokes, breathing, flip-turns, competitive starts and building endurance and self-confidence. Campers are broken into groups based on their swimming abilities and develop their skills. After Tennis & Aquatics camp, the participants will return to Osprey Camp for more activities.

NOTES: Tennis and Aquatics camp runs from Monday-Thursday. Campers will attend OSPREY camp on Friday.

Campers must: be yellow or green band, have the ability to swim 25 yards without holding on, be able to jump in and touch the bottom, and tread water for 30 seconds.

TEEN CAMPS

Teen Camp (Ages 12-15)

Teen Camp gives campers the opportunity to get out of the house and get involved. This camp shows that it is still fun to be a kid involved in positive organizations at an age where peer pressure is strong. Additionally, our Teen Camp fosters leadership development by giving campers the opportunity to help with decision making, planning and activity coordinating. Campers will also participate in field trips, swimming, team building, and outdoor fun!
